

CONSTITUTION
OF
ROLLING HILLS MEN’S CLUB

ARTICLE I: NAME AND PURPOSE

Section 1: The name of this organization shall be Rolling Hills Men’s Club.

Section 2: The purpose of this organization shall be to arrange and conduct tournaments for members of this club; to hold meetings for the purpose of handling the club’s business; to promote good fellowship amongst its members; and, in general, promote the best interest of golf in the community.

ARTICLE II: MEMBERSHIP

Section 1: Regular members of this club shall be at least age 18 as of January 31, in the current year of membership.

Section 2: Junior members of this club are those that have not attained the age of 18 as of January 31, in the current year of membership.

ARTICLE III: OFFICERS AND DUTIES

Section 1: Any regular or senior member in good standing is eligible to hold office in the Men’s Club.

Section 2: The Officers of this Club shall be President, Vice-President, Treasurer, and Secretary. They together shall comprise the Board of Directors. The President and Treasurer shall be elected in the even years for 2-year terms; the Vice-President and Secretary shall be elected in the odd years for 2-year terms. Officers of the club are eligible for re-election at the discretion of the membership. The resident club professional will function as advisor to the Board and to the Club but shall not have a vote.

Section 3: The Officers of this Club shall be nominated and elected at the November General Meeting and shall take office at the Annual Awards Banquet.

Section 4: The President’s term of office shall be for two (2) full years, unless the Vice-President is required to fill an unexpired term. The President shall preside at all regular and executive board meetings; establish policy in the absence of a scheduled meeting; and serve as the spokesperson of the Rolling Hills Men’s Club. In addition, he:

- A. Shall appoint the Weekend Tournament Director.
- B. Shall appoint the Weekday Tournament Director.
- C. Shall appoint a Handicap Chairman.

- D. Shall appoint the Club's Website Manager.
- E. Shall appoint the Club's Sponsorship Chairman.
- F. Shall appoint the Finance Committee, if necessary.

Section 5: The Vice-President's term shall be for two (2) full years. The Vice-President shall serve in the absence of the President and shall be the liaison to the club committees. In addition, he:

- A. Shall maintain the white information board.
- B. Shall Procure the turkeys for the Turkey Shoot Tournament.
- C. Shall acquire/deliver Trophy Plates and Award Plaques from Evergreen Trophy for the Awards Banquet.

Section 6: The Secretary's term shall be for two (2) full years. He shall:

- A. Take the minutes at all General and Officer's Meetings.
- B. Track the President's Cup Points and post results.
- C.

Section 7: The Treasurer's term shall be two (2) full years. He shall;

- A. Be responsible for all Men's Club operating funds.
- B. Chair the Finance Committee, if one has been appointed.
- C. Provide Monthly Balance Sheets.
- D. Provide an Annual Audit.

ARTICLE IV: MEETINGS

Section 1: General Meetings of the Men's Club shall be held on such date and place as designated by the President.

Section 2: Special Meetings shall be required upon written request of ten (10) percent of the total membership, who shall be in good standing, and presented to the President, who shall set a meeting within fifteen (15) days. The Secretary shall notify all members of record, via e-mail and bulletin board posting as to time and place.

Section 3: The Semi-Annual Meetings of the Men's Club shall be held at the first Shotgun Start tournament in March, and on or before the date of the last tournament in November.

Section 4: Executive Board and Advisory Board Meetings are normally held monthly as announced by the President.

ARTICLE V: TERMINATION

The Board of Directors, by a majority vote, may suspend or terminate a member for violation of the By-laws or for conduct which may be injurious to the interest of the club. Before finalizing such action, the Board shall give ten (10) days' notice to the member, in writing, of the charges to such member. The member shall be entitled to present evidence in his defense before the final decision.


ARTICLE VI: AMENDMENTS

Section 1: Amendments to the Constitution shall be presented in writing, with language fully developed prior to a vote.


Section 2: The Constitution may be amended by an affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the members in attendance.
